## Before and After School Supervision

Students should arrive at school and leave school at reasonable times unless they are involved in supervised school activities. For student safety, we ask parents/caregivers to ensure that their child arrives at school after 8.15 am and have left the schoolgrounds by 3.15 pm. An out of school care programme is available. Parents/Caregivers can contact the school office for details.

If students need help to contact their parents/caregivers or emergency contacts after school, the school takes responsibility for their care until an appropriate arrangement is made. In exceptional circumstances, this may include contacting the police, and/or Oranga Tamariki.
